ORDINANCE NO. 2020-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE NON -DISTRICT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 BY PROVIDING FOR CHANGES IDENTIFIED IN EXHIBIT A TO TRANSFER \$8,000,000 FROM THE SEWER CAPACITY FEE FUND BALANCE FOR A DEVELOPER REIMBURSEMENT RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND \$82,000 IN THE FORFEITURE FUND FROM CONFISCATED PROPERTY FOR OPERATING SUPPLIES AND A DONATION FOR TEEN COURT; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2019-41 approved the Non-District Budget for fiscal year 2019-20; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to amend the Non-District Budget for supplemental appropriations in the amounts identified in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Section 166.241(4)(c) Florida Statutes require such a budget amendment be adopted in the same manner as the original budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – FINDINGS

1.01 The recitals outlined above are incorporated by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 2 – ADOPTION

2.01 The Non-District Budget for fiscal year 2019-20 is hereby amended by providing for changes identified in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if set forth herein.

SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance or portions thereof, the provisions of this ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY

4.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE

5.01 This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
