Hurricane Ian struck North Port on September 29, 2022, leaving in its wake a trail of damages which caused the temporary closure of Warm Mineral Springs Park (WMSP). This revenue generating location has remained closed since the storm. Based upon past performance, revenue lost due to this closure is approximately \$633,301 in total for October through January admissions. Commission provided direction for the City to reopen this attraction as expeditiously as possible. Rental of two temporary trailer for operations at Warm Mineral springs was approved under an Exigency request on December 29, 2022. This exigency request is for the electrical connections to those trailers and pump house, ADA-compliant connecting sidewalk, and reconfiguration of security fencing which will allow the park to open safely.

- Prep and install concrete sidewalk at 4" thick and 4' wide as indicated on drawings
- Install required transformer housekeeping pad
- Relocate temp chain link fencing to protect building
- Power from FPL pole to meter.
- Power and distribution systems consisting of: new panel, fused disconnects, meter can transformer, conduit and wire for the new field office, domestic water pump house, existing lift station, and portable restroom building (no branch or control wiring pricing is included for any structure only feeder wiring and connections).
  - o All hand trenching
  - o PVC Sch 80 UG install at 8" deep with red dye concrete encasement
- Sodding and final clean-up
- Temp Fence Removal and Storage
