**Description:** At the December 2, 2024 workshop, the City Commission had unanimous consensus to include a charter referendum question on the March 11, 2025 special election to amend Section 1.02(b) of the City Charter authorizing the city to borrow in situations for local, state, national declared emergency. At the December 10, 2024 meeting, the City Commission voted 5-0 to approve ordinance and move to 2nd reading at a date to be determined, amending the referendum date to May 13, 2025. Based on the discussion, ordinance should copy the failed referendum from November 2024 and limit to only the emergency part. First Reading = December 10, 2024 Second Reading = January 28, 2025 The deadline to have the referendum questions to the SOE is February 17, 2025. First reading of the ordinance on December 10 CRAB set for December 18 Second reading January 28
