Please indicate on the Speaker Card by writing Public Comment if you wish to speak under that portion of the meeting or specify the individual agenda item you wish to speak to. Please wait until you are recognized by the presiding Officer, state your name so that your comments may be properly recorded and limit your remarks to a period of three (3) minutes or less. The City Commission will act on an Agenda Item after comments from the Staff, Petitioner and Public have been heard.

Florida's Sunshine Law requires the Commission to discuss this Agenda only in open session. The Commissioners cannot discuss these items with each other before this meeting is called to order. The Commissioners, individually, can however, discuss any item with concerned citizens and staff in preparation for the meeting.
