ORDINANCE NO. 2014-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, ADOPTING CHAPTER 4, BOARDS AND COMMITTEES, ARTICLE VI, OF THE NORTH PORT CODE ESTABLISHING THE COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

- SECTION 1 ADOPTION OF ARTICLE VI, OF NORTH PORT CITY CODE ESTABLISHING THE COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD
 - 1.01 The North Port City Commission hereby adopts Part II, Chapter 4, Boards and Committees, Article VI, of the City Code, establishing the Community Economic Development Advisory Board, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2 - SEVERABILITY

2.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

SECTION 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE.

3.01 This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

EXHIBIT A

CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE VI, COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD

Sec. 4-150. Establishment

The Community Economic Development Advisory Board, is hereby created and established for the purpose of advising the City Commission on business and economic development and issues of importance to the North Port business community and citizens.

Sec. 4-151. Membership

- A. The Community Economic Development Advisory Board shall consist of up to eleven (11) regular members representing the following categories:
 - 1. Financial Services
 - 2. Real Estate
 - 3. Medical & Health Care
 - Development, Engineering or Planning
 - 5. Higher Education/School Board Member
 - 6. Home Owners Association board member
 - 7. Tourism
 - 8. Diversified Light Industrial/Manufacturing
 - 9. Public Relations
 - 10. Land Use Attorney
 - 11. North Port resident with no business or specific organizational affiliation

A North Port City Commissioner shall serve as an ex officio member, with no voting rights.

There shall be no alternates.

B. Members of the advisory board shall be appointed by the City Commission for a term of two (2) years. However, for the inaugural term, five (5) members of the advisory board will serve an initial term of one (1) year, with the other six (6) members serving an initial term of two (2) years. Thereafter, all terms shall be for two years.

Sec. 4-152. Residency Requirement

Preference will be given to qualified applicants who are also City residents. It is preferred that a majority of the appointed members of the Board shall be City residents. However, in cases where local residents are unable or unavailable to fill a specific category, applicants who are not City residents will be considered for membership.

Sec. 4-153. Meetings

The Board shall meet at least quarterly, but may hold additional meetings as needed.

Sec. 4-154. Power and duties

- A. The Community Economic Development Advisory Board shall serve in an advisory capacity and shall work with the City Manager and staff as appointed by the City Manager in researching, developing and recommending business and economic development policies necessary to direct the orderly economic growth of the City.
- **B.** The Community Economic Development Advisory Board shall work with the City Manager and staff as appointed by the City Manager to support the City's business and economic development activities as follows:
 - 1. Make recommendations on any updates to the City's Business and Economic Development Strategic Plan with long-term goals and objectives.
 - 2. Provide recommendations on any City Commission short-term action plans and measurements.
 - 3. Make recommendations on resources allocated for economic development activity of the City.
 - 4. Provide recommendations on policies and ordinances affecting economic development.
