Resolution No. 2016-R-07, levy and adoption of Solid Waste District non-ad valorem assessment rates and certification of Solid Waste District non-ad valorem assessment rolls for fiscal year 2016-2017.

City Clerk Adkins read Resolution No. 2016-R-07 into the record by title only and City Manager Lewis provided a brief overview, stating there is no change in the rate for this year. Public comment was held and there were no questions from the Commission.
