**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION IN PART AND  
DEFERRING JUDGMENT ON PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

THIS ACTION came before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Summary Judgment on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 2015, and upon hearing argument of counsel and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The City's Motion for Preliminary Injunction is granted in part.
2. The selling of dogs by the Defendants from 1668 Tropicaire Blvd. within the City of North Port Florida (the "Property") is unlawful.
3. The Defendants are enjoined from selling dogs from the Property.
4. Within five (5) days of the issuance of this Injunction, the Defendants shall file a sworn report with the Court stating that no dogs are for sale from the property, and providing confirmation of the steps the Defendants are taking to comply with the injunction.
5. No bond is required.
6. No action is taken on the Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment at this time. ~~Judgment is deferred.~~ Plaintiff may re-notice the Motion of Summary Judgment at their convenience.
