ORDINANCE NO. 2017-36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE SOLID WASTE DISTRICT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 BY PROVIDING FOR SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNTS IDENTIFIED IN EXHIBIT A; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2016-31, the City of North Port, Florida has adopted the Solid Waste District Budget for fiscal year 2016-17; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Port desires to amend the Solid Waste District Budget for supplemental appropriations in the amounts identified in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Section 166.241(4)(c) Florida Statutes require such a budget amendment be adopted in the same manner as the original budget.

NOW, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA THAT:

- SECTION 1 The Solid Waste District Budget for fiscal year 2016-17 is hereby amended by providing for supplemental appropriations in the amounts identified in Exhibit A.
- SECTION 2 SEVERABILITY
 - 2.01 If any section, subsection, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
- SECTION 3 CONFLICTS
 - 3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, or portions thereof, the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE

4.01 - The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
