RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R-19, THEREBY DISSOLVING THE MEDICAL HOSPITAL TASK FORCE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2016, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2016-R-

21 creating the Medical Hospital Task Force; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2017, the City Commission voted to repeal Resolution No. 2016-R-21 and adopted Resolution No. 2017-R-19, creating the requirements for the Medical Hospital Task Force; providing for membership, meetings and quorums; and providing for duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.05 of the City Charter, the City Commission may appoint advisory boards and committees composed of citizens qualifies to act in an advisory capacity to the City, the members of which shall serve for a fixed time in their appointments or at the pleasure of the Commission; and **WHEREAS**, City Code Section 4-3(c) provides that advisory board members serve at the pleasure of the City Commission and may be removed by a majority vote of the Commission; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2017-R-19, Section 1.04, membership in the Medical Hospital Task Force shall end when the Resolution creating the Task Force is repealed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2007-R-19, Section 4.01, the Resolution shall be repealed automatically either twelve (12) months after the first meeting of the Medical Hospital Task Force or on September 30, 2018, whichever date is the later; and

WHEREAS, at its November 2, 2017 special meeting, the City Commission unanimously voted to disband the Medical Hospital Task Force.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 – REPEAL

1.01 The City Commission hereby repeals Resolution No. 2017-R-19 in its entirety.

SECTION 2 – CONFLICTS

2.01 In the event of any conflicts between the provisions of this Resolution and any other Resolution, the provisions of this Resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3 – SEVERABILITY

3.01 If any section, subsection, or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a

separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4 – EFFECTIVE DATE

4.01 This Resolution shall take effect immediately after adoption by the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida.
