#### **CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL**

The North Port Road & Drainage District Governing Body Regular Meeting was called to order at 4:45 p.m. in Chambers by Mayor Carusone.

Present: Mayor Carusone; Vice-Mayor Yates; Commissioners Hanks, Luke and McDowell; City Manager Lear; City Attorney Slayton; City Clerk Adkins; Deputy City Clerk Peto and Police Chief Vespia.

#### 1. APPROVAL OF AGENDA - COMMISSION

A motion was made by Vice-Mayor Yates, seconded by Commissioner Luke, to approve the Agenda as presented. The motion carried by the following vote:

#### 2. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Public comment was held 4:50 p.m. - 4:53 p.m. Martin Lumpert: Drainage and grass cut on his property.

Subsequent to public comment, Public Works Director Bellia explained the schedule for cutting his ditch and what is being done to help alleviate his concerns regarding mowing near his fence. City Manager Lear stated he will provide a mowing schedule and an update of previous concerns that Mr. Lumpert had submitted by the end of the week.

**A.** <u>18-034</u> Approval of Minutes for the September 7, 2017 Road & Drainage District Special Meeting Budget Hearing.

#### **B.** 17-1579

Agreements with Florida Power & Light for the placement of streetlights at thirty-three (33) school bus stop locations with electrical costs of approximately \$4,000 annually. The project was budgeted, and funding is available in Fiscal Year 2018 for Streetlights at School Bus Stops.

Discussion ensued: (1) following a question, it was stated that streetlights at the 33 bus stop locations will be up and functional in approximately 12 weeks; (2) clarification was provided that the Recommended Action line on the Staff Summary Sheet should state at the end of the last sentence: "with electrical costs of approximately \$4,000." It was stated that should there be opportunity for more streetlights, the budgeted amount of \$8,000 will help reach the goal of 60 bus stop locations. There was no public comment.

A motion was made by Commissioner McDowell, seconded by Commissioner Hanks, to approve Consent Agenda Item B. The motion carried by the following vote:

Clarification was provided that the motion was estimated for \$4,000.
