## **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R-21**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE FIRE RESCUE DISTRICT ESTABLISHING NOT-TO-EXCEED NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT RATES FOR THE NORTH PORT FIRE RESCUE DISTRICT FOR THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of North Port ("the City") provides fire suppression and protection service and first response service to residents and properties through a Dependent Special District known as the North Port Fire Rescue District ("District"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 66 Article II of the Code of the City of North Port, the Governing Body (Commission) shall have the duty, right, power and authority to levy by Resolution and collect special assessments against all non-exempted benefited property within its territorial bounds in order to provide funds for the purpose of Fire Rescue and First Responder responsibility of the North Port Fire Rescue District, and

WHEREAS, fire rescue services, including first responder medical service provides a special benefit in the form of response readiness to respond to emergency calls without discrimination as to property type or location within the District, and

WHEREAS, fire rescue services, provide an additional special benefit to improved parcels through the response and protection from damage or loss of structures on the property and the ability for those properties to obtain fire insurance at attractive rates, and the provision of first responder medical service, and

WHEREAS, the provision of fire rescue services provides special public health, safety and welfare benefits to all protected property and residents within the City of North Port, and

WHEREAS, the District has levied special assessments for fiscal year 2016-2017 pursuant to a plan and methodology which the District has determined to satisfy the rational basis for a fire rescue special assessment and the equitable, proportional distribution of said assessment required by relevant Florida legal standards and controlling case law, and

WHEREAS, the District intends to levy non-ad valorem assessments for fiscal year 2017-2018 pursuant to a plan and methodology which has determined all North Port properties unless otherwise exempt receive a special benefit from Fire Rescue District services and that the non-ad valorem assessments are fairly apportioned to those properties that receive such benefit as required by relevant Florida legal standards and controlling case law, and



**WHEREAS**, the District wishes to provide said notice through the TRIM Notice and Notice of Proposed Taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, SERVING AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE NORTH PORT FIRE RESCUE DISTRICT, TO WIT:

#### SECTION 1 - NORTH PORT FIRE RESCUE DISTRICT ASSESSMENT RATES

- 1.01 The City Commission hereby adopts the rates shown in Appendix A as not-to-exceed rates for the North Port Fire Rescue District for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. Fiscal Year 2017-2018 begins October 1, 2017 and ends September 30, 2018.
- 1.02 The City Commission hereby clarifies that the rates are established only as not-to-exceed rates and this action does not officially adopt any rates for the 2017-2018 fiscal year.
- 1.03 The City Commission hereby authorizes staff to notify property owners of the rates by participation in the Sarasota County TRIM Notice and Proposed Notice of Taxes.

## SECTION 2 - CONFLICTS

2.01 If there is any conflict between the provisions of this Resolution and any other resolution or portions thereof, the provisions of this Resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

#### SECTION 3 - SEVERABILITY

3.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

### SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE

4.01 This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
