ORDINANCE NO. 2018-56

1AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY OF2NORTH PORT UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE TO ALLOW FOR PAWN SHOPS AS A3PERMITTED USE IN ACTIVITY CENTER 1 BY AMENDING CHAPTER 55 - ACTIVITY CENTER4DESIGN REGULATIONS, ARTICLE I. – MEDITERRANEA (ACTIVITY CENTER #1); PROVIDING5FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING6FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODING OF AMENDMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR7AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, on October 9, 2018, the City Commission of the City of North Port directed staff to bring back
 an ordinance removing the prohibition for pawn shops as a nonconforming use in Activity Center 1 and
 adding pawn shops as a permitted use; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2018, the City of North Port Planning and Zoning Advisory Board, designated
 as the Local Planning Agency (LPA) for the City, held a properly noticed public hearing to receive public
 comments on the revision of the Unified Land Development Code; and

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WHEREAS, the City Commission has held properly-noticed public hearings to review the
 recommendations of the Planning and Zoning Advisory Board and to receive public comments on the
 revision of the Unified Land Development Code; and

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WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the proposed amendments serve the public health,
 safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA,
