Intent of the Beautification Program

- Incentivize businesses to bring landscaping up to current code requirements
- Increase the tax base of the City of North Port
- Increase economic development opportunities in the North Port area
- Create an attractive streetscape theme along our most traveled thoroughfare
- Attract business interest along US 41

Applicant's responsibility to obtain funding

- Install and or maintain existing irrigation that will be adequate to sustain the health and vitality of the planted materials
- Continual maintenance of landscaping
- Replacement of failed plant material

Allowable use of monies available for Beautification efforts

- Perimeter buffering consistent with today's code requirements
- Landscaping frontages along US Hwy 41
- Interior landscaping required to meet 35% canopy coverage

Funding for Beautification Program

- Funding sources for the Beautification program to be determined by Commission of the City of North Port
- Proposing an annual allotment of \$20,000 with \$5,000 available to each applicant
- Applicant will be responsible for obtaining a minimum of three quotes for City approval
- City staff will review and approve each application based on Florida Friendly landscaping practices and U.L.D.C. compliance
