# POLLING PLACE AGREEMENT

THIS POLLING PLACE AGREEMENT is entered into on the . 2016 day of Owner"), <u>4970 CITY HALL BLVD</u> between CITY OF NORTH PORT Florida and the Supervisor of Elections of Sarasota County, Florida (the "Supervisor"), 101 South 34286-4100 Washington Boulevard, Sarasota, Florida 34236, regarding use of the premises located at 6207 WEST PRICE BLVD NORTH PORT FL 34291 (the "Premises").

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

#### AGREEMENT

- 1. Agreement: Owner shall provide the MORGAN FAMILY COMM. CTR/MEETING ROOM 136/139 **A&B** (specify room), located at the Premises as a polling place for the elections indicated below:
  - (1)City of North Port Special Primary Election, March 14, 2017 (if required)  $\frac{\mathbf{X}}{\mathbf{X}}$
  - North Port Special Election, May 9, 2017 (2)

#### 2. Access to Premises/Polling Place:

- a. Prior to Election Day: Owner or designee shall provide access to the Premises for delivery and storage of election equipment. Equipment delivery dates for the 2017 elections are as follows:
- 3/13/2017 (1) City of North Port Special Primary Election, March 14, 2017 (if required) 5/8/2017 (2) North Port Special Election, May 9, 2017

If possible, access to polling room is requested to set the equipment up on the Monday before election.

- b. Election Day: Owner or designee shall provide access to the Polling Place by one of the following means (check one):

  - 3) Owner will provide key to the Supervisor or designated staff member \_\_\_\_\_
- c. Post-Election Day: Owner or designee shall provide access to the Premises for pick up of the election equipment on the following dates:

  - North Port Special Election, May 9, 2017 (2)

- **4. Compensation:** As compensation for use of the Premises as Polling Place, the City of North Port shall pay the Owner <u>\$0.</u> per election. Payment shall be made within four (4) weeks following each election, and checks shall be payable to the Owner sent to the address first indicated above, unless stated otherwise. (Address, if different from above.)

### 6. Owner's Responsibilities:

- a. Access to the Polling Place shall be available to Poll Workers no later than 6 a.m. on Election Day.
- b. The parking lot or parking area at the Premises shall be clear of all obstructions that would impede voter access on Election Day. No other events shall be planned that will affect and limit the amount of available parking for persons coming to vote.
- c. Disability permit-only parking spaces shall be available to voters. Supervisor may provide temporary solutions if unavailable.
- d. All indoor, outdoor and parking area lights shall be operational and in good working order on Election Day.
- e. All electrical outlets in Polling Room shall be in good working order.
- f. Unencumbered access shall be provided to dedicated phone line maintained by the Supervisor of Elections. Our clerk needs the ability to contact our office and transmit precinct results on Election Day.
- g. The area outside of 100' from the entrance to the polling location (building) is the responsibility of the owner. The owner may not infringe upon the public's First Amendment rights.

- h. The area outside of 100' from the entrance to the polling location (building) is the responsibility of the owner. The owner may not infringe upon the public's First Amendment rights.
- i. The Polling Place shall remain open until officially closed by Supervisor personnel and precinct tabulation is completed.
- j. The Polling Room shall be used exclusively for election business on Election Day. No other activity shall take place in the Polling Room until Poll Workers complete the tabulation, close and leave the Premises.
- k. The Owner shall provide a secure storage area for election equipment from date of delivery to date of pickup. The storage area shall remain locked with access available only to designated election personnel.
- 1. In the event that Poll Workers or Supervisor personnel are unable to gain entry to the Polling Place on Election Day, the Owner shall allow the Supervisor to hire a professional locksmith to gain entry to the Premises.
- 7. Indemnification; Insurance: Subject to the limitations set forth in §768.28, Florida Statutes, the parties shall each be responsible for their own acts and omissions in the performance of their duties hereunder, and the acts and omissions of their own employees and agents, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the other party from and against any and all claims, incurred by the other party arising from such acts and omissions. The City of North Port, as a municipal government, is self-insured. As a constitutional officer of Sarasota County, the Supervisor is also self-insured.
- 8. Force Majeure: Owner shall not be liable for any adjustments or suspension of performance, failure of performance or any damages resulting from any of the following: strikes or labor disputes, war stoppages, fire, explosions, water, the elements, acts of God, acts of civil or military authorities or public enemy, or other similar causes beyond Owner's control.

### 9. Miscellaneous:

- 9.1 The rights and obligations of the parties set forth herein may be altered only by a written amendment or modification executed by the parties hereto.
- 9.2 This Contract is deemed made and governed by the laws of the State of Florida.
