



Traffic Signals On US 41 Between Salford Boulevard and Sumter Boulevard
January 10, 2017





- ✓ Florida Department of Transportation will be widening U.S. 41 between Salford Boulevard and Sumter Boulevard
- ✓ Traffic signal poles and mast arms will be replaced with galvanized metal finish at the following intersections:
 - Salford Boulevard
 - Cocoplum Village Shops
 - Sumter Boulevard





- ✓ Traffic signal poles and mast arms currently painted City Center Green are:
 - > Salford Boulevard
 - Sumter Boulevard
 - North Port Boulevard
 - Pan American Boulevard
 - Biscayne Drive





- ✓ The Planning Division Manager provided a finding that public amnesties required to be City Center Green are benches, furniture, streetlights, etc.
- ✓ A traffic signal is not an urban amenity or a way finding furniture and traffic infrastructure are not one and the same



- ✓ In conclusion, it was found that Urban Design Standards
 Pattern Book does not consider signal mast arms to be
 included in urban outdoor street furniture (it would be public
 infrastructure) and would therefore not be required to be
 painted City Center Green
- ✓ The decision to require
 public infrastructure to be
 painted City Center Green
 would solely be at the
 discretion of the City



Costs





Installation

✓ FDOT's estimated cost to powder coat the three traffic signal

poles and mast at Salford Boulevard, Cocoplum Village Shops Driveway and Sumter Boulevard arms during installation is \$27, 500



Maintenance

- ✓ Requires painting of traffic signal poles and mast arms every six years
- ✓ Approximate cost for painting the three traffic signal poles and mast arms is approximately \$42,640

Option 1





- ✓ Require three traffic signal poles and mast arms be painted City Center Green for an initial cost of \$27,500
- ✓ Maintenance cost every six years thereafter a total of \$42,640
- ✓ City of North Port and FDOT enter into Locally Funded Agreement and Transportation On System Post Project Maintenance Agreement

Option 2





- ✓ The traffic signals and mast arms will be constructed by FDOT with a galvanized metal finish. FDOT will assume entire cost for construction
- ✓ Execution of the two above referenced agreements will not be required
