NORTH PORT YMCA EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION CENTER

The North Port Community Served by The SKY Family YMCA

- **60%** of the families enrolled in the North Port center are considered working poor, living at or below the poverty line
- More than **20%** of the children spend more than 57 hours per week in our care
- **75%** of children served, are receiving financial assistance; the average awarded amount is **50%** off the weekly fee
- **100%** of the children receive **FREE** breakfast, lunch and snack daily, this sometimes being the only meals they eat daily
- The YMCA anticipates providing over **\$77,000** annually in financial assistance to the children in this early childhood education center

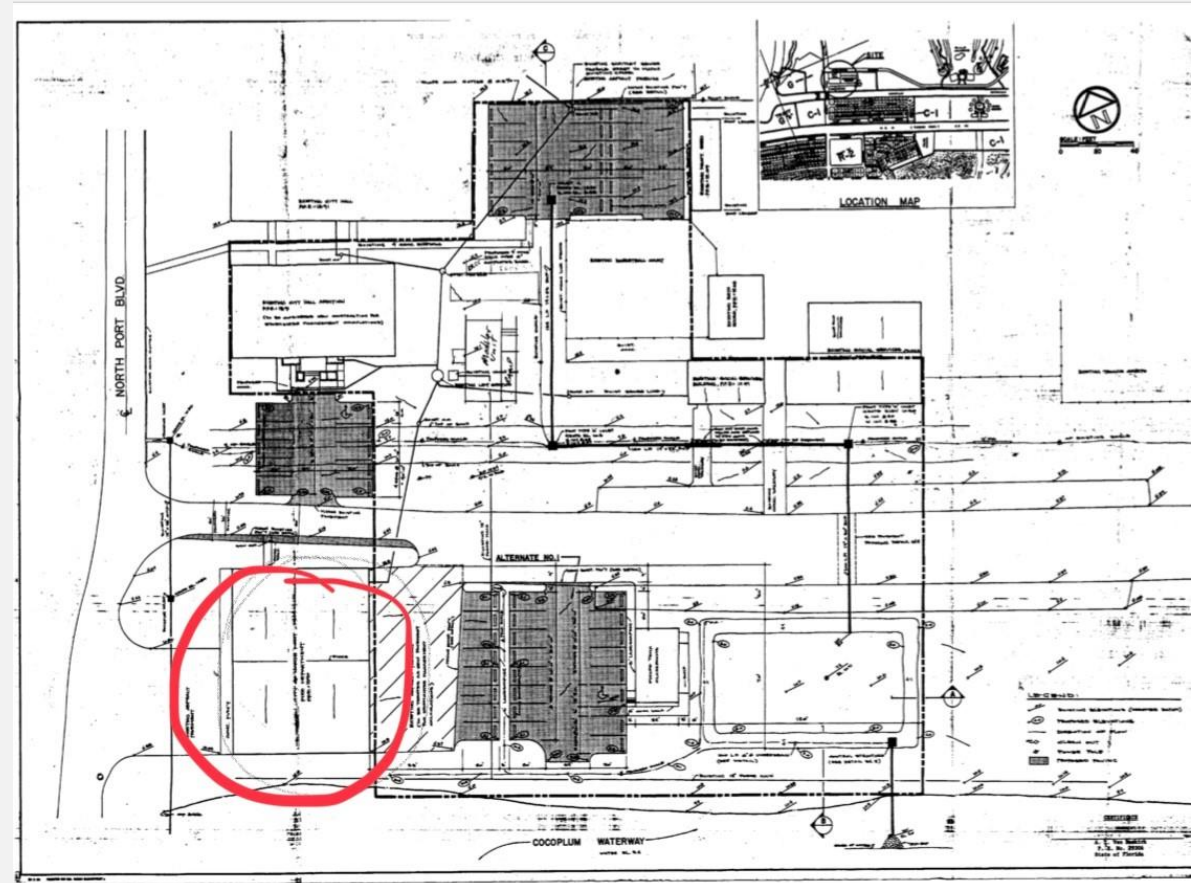
NORTH PORT YMCA EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION CENTER – NEW BUILD

Based on the current site shown to the right, the center will be designed to fit the site but will cater to the exact location and needs of the community.

The proposed site will include the following:

- The center will hold 125 children, ages 6 weeks to 5 years
- The center will have outside play areas for infants, toddlers & children ages 3-5
- The center will follow the Sunshine Education Academy initiative that the other Y early learning centers already follow
- The center will be licensed through the Department of Health, Department of Children and Families, Early Learning Coalition and Voluntary Pre Kindergarten

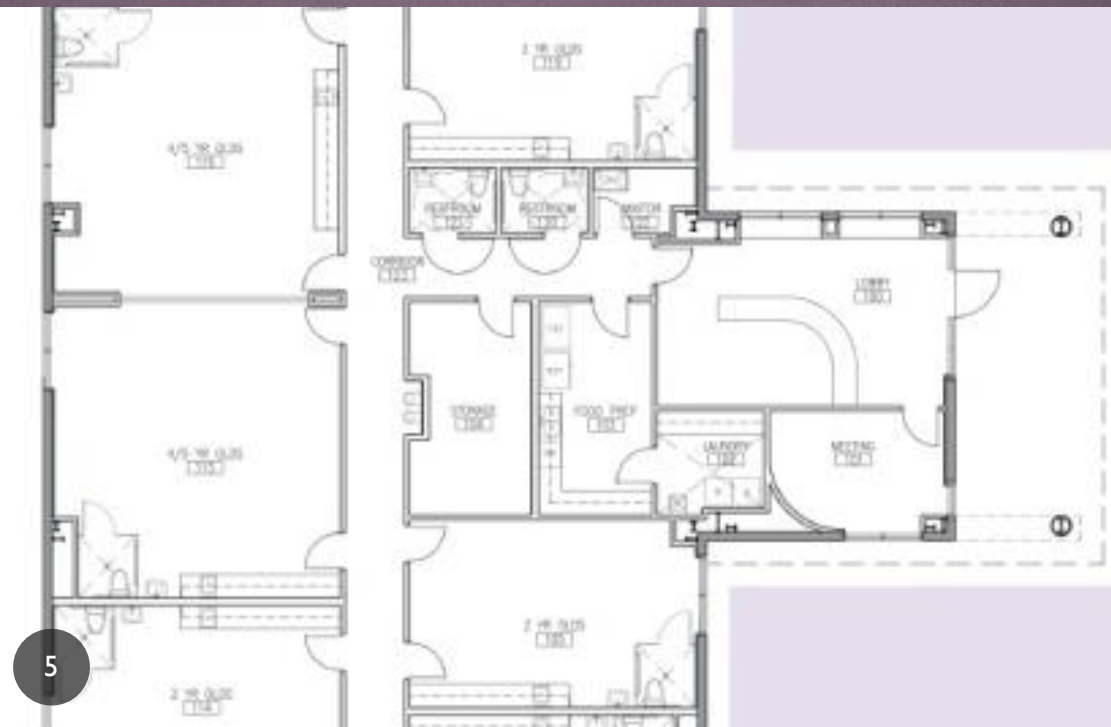
POTENTIAL LOCATION ON THE SITE

To the left is the design for the YMCA's newly built Sunshine Education facility in Venice which opened in December of 2018. The total cost of this project was about \$1.9 million all included.

To complete install a brand new pool, the following needs to be completed

- Demolish entire pool tank and deck
- Replace with 6 lane 25 meter pool
- Install new equipment
- Replace pool deck and surrounding brick pavers
- Based on the information provided
