

BISCAYNE DRIVE MEDIANS CROSSWALKS ANALYSIS







SOUTH BISCAYNE DRIVE CROSSWALKS ANALYSIS



- January 24, 2017: City Commission approved Contract No. 2017-08 between C-Squared Certified General Contractor, Inc. to construct curbing around the South Biscayne Drive medians subject to the following conditions:
 - 1. Conduct crosswalk analysis and bring back to the City Commission at the next possible meeting.
 - 2. Adding the responsibility of Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) back to the contractor.
- Criteria for Crosswalks:
 - 1. Sidewalks on both sides of South Biscayne Drive
 - 2. Crosswalks cannot conflict with vehicular traffic movement
 - 3. Width and location of intersection must be conducive to the safety of the crosswalk
- January 30, 2017: Staff conducted crosswalk analysis and site inspection to determine the need for pedestrian crosswalks within the median improvements of South Biscayne Drive project limits between Safford Terrace and Elyton Drive.



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- The only location that met all of the criteria for crosswalks was the intersection of South Biscayne Drive and Hyde Park Avenue.
- Staff has determined that one additional crosswalk at the South Biscayne Drive and Hyde Park Avenue intersection should be constructed.
- Staff will process an administrative change order in the amount of \$2,807.18 with C-Squared Certified General Contractors, Inc. for construction of the additional crosswalk.
