- Each member serves a one-year term which will consist of a minimum of 5 community projects or events

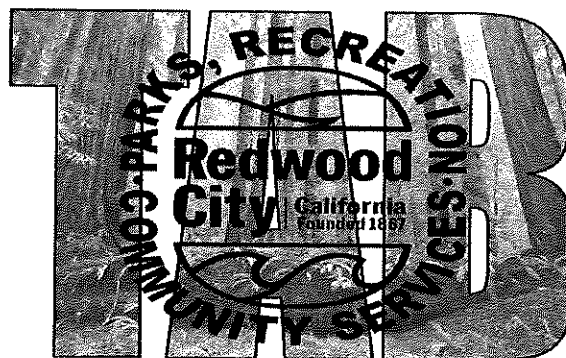
What is the TAB responsible for?
