April 2012

 Butler Park 25M Pool (\$5M Medium Family Aquatic Center) completed and permitted

June 2012 - January 2016

Project on hold awaiting direction and funding allocation

March 2017 - May 2017

Workshops with Commission to evaluate improved and expanded options

Butler Park Pool 2017 Update

(Commission Directed Options to Consider)

- Stretch 25Y Multi-Use Pool (Heated w/ Bulkheads)
- Lazy River with Zero Depth Beach Entry
- Children's Play Pool w/ Water Play Structure
- Water Slides Including Teen Drop or Bowl Slide
- Support Buildings
- Lighting, Fencing, Shade
- Concrete Pool Deck (Staging /Spectator Seating)
- Spray Features
- Budget Range \$10M to \$12M Total Project Costs


