ORDINANCE NO. 2019-31

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 78 – UTILITIES, ARTICLE II – WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY, TO ADJUST CAPACITY FEES AND PROVIDE REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO RECLAIMED WATER CHARGES AND WASTEWATER SYSTEM RATE SCHEDULES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a formal analysis of the City's water and wastewater utility rates was last performed in 2015 and the current water and wastewater user rates have been in effect since October 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City contracted with GovRates, Inc. to review and analyze the City's water and wastewater utility rates and to prepare a financial forecast for Fiscal Year 2019 through Fiscal Year 2029; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2019, the City Commission held a properly-noticed public meeting to review the analysis, findings, and recommendations of GovRates, Inc. and to receive public comments on adjusting the City's water and wastewater utility rates and fees; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the proposed amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

2.01 The City Commission hereby approves and adopts the following amendments to the Code of the City of North Port, Florida:

"Chapter 78 – UTILITIES

27 ...

ARTICLE II. – WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY

29 . . . 30 31 Sec. 78-30. - Water and wastewater capacity fees. 32 33 (a) Adoption. The city hereby adopts and establishes pursuant to general law, a water capacity 34 fee and a wastewater capacity fee, the purpose of which will be to finance capital 35 expenditures and the payment of city indebtedness associated with the expansion of the city's 36 water treatment and transmission system and the wastewater collection, treatment, and 37 effluent disposal system. The water capacity fee imposed by the city shall be \$1,890.00 38 \$1,872.00 per ERC, and the wastewater capacity fee shall be \$2,575.00 \$2,213.00 per ERC. 39 (d) Determination of equivalent residential connection factors "ERC" for water and wastewater 40 41 services. 42 . . . 43 (2) One equivalent residential connection (ERC) shall, for purposes of this section, have an 44 assigned value of 1.00. For wastewater service capacity, one ERC is hereby established 45 and determined to be equal to a flow of 225 155 gallons per day, average annual basis 46 (225 155 GPD). 47 48 (3) For water service capacity, one ERC is hereby established and determined to be equal to 49 a flow of 250 170 gallons per day, average annual basis (250 170 GPD). 50 51 (5) For all establishments not listed above: 52 53 a. The total water equivalent residential connection (ERC) value for water service 54 capacity shall be determined by multiplying the number of fixture units, as published 55 in the Standard Plumbing Code, as amended, by 30, and then dividing that numerator 56 by 250 170. For example: 57 Number of Fixture Units x 30 Total Water ERC Value = 250 GPD/ERC 58 *Number of Fixture Units x 30* Total Water ERC Value Ξ 170 GPD/ERC 59 60 b. The total water equivalent residential connection (ERC) value for wastewater service 61 capacity shall be determined by multiplying the number of fixture units, as published in the Standard Plumbing Code, as amended, by 30, and then dividing that numerator 62 63 by 225 155. For example: 64 Number of Fixture Units x 30 Total Wastewater ERC Value = 225 GPD/ERC 65 Number of Fixture Units x 30 Total Wastewater ERC Value 155 GPD/ERC

67 The water capacity fees shall be determined by using the following formula: 68 Total ERC Value x \$1,890.00 Water Capacity Fee 69 70 Total ERC Value x \$1,872.00 = Water Capacity Fee71 The wastewater capacity fees shall be determined by using the following formula: 72 Total ERC Value × \$2,575.00 Wastewater Capacity Fee 73 74 Total ERC Value x \$2,213.00 = Wastewater Capacity Fee 75 76 (9) Effective date. In accordance with Florida Statute and to allow for customers currently 77 contemplating connecting to the city's water and/or wastewater system(s) to connect at 78 the lower rate, The effective date of the increase change in capacity fees shall be on the 79 first day of the utility billing cycle in October 2019. effective on January 1, 2017." 80 81 2.02 The City Commission hereby approves and adopts the following amendments to the Code of the 82 City of North Port, Florida: 83 84 "Chapter 78 – UTILITIES 85 ARTICLE II. - WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY 86 87 88 89 Sec. 78-35. - Reclaimed water charges. 90 91 The city shall establish and adopt by separate resolution, a utility rate schedule and incorporate a 92 retail rate and a wholesale rate for the sale of reclaimed water. Billing shall be handled as provided 93 in section 78-24 hereof. 94 . . . 95 96 Sec. 78-39. - Establishment of a wastewater system rate schedule. 97 98 The city commission shall establish and adopt by separate resolution a wastewater system rate 99 schedule to include a base facility charge, flat rate, and a usage charge. The city commission may modify the wastewater rate schedule from time to time by resolution." 100 101 102 **SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS** 103 104 3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance or 105 portions thereof, the provisions of this ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict. 106
