Membership and Programs Refund Policy:	

Full or prorated refunds may be approved:

(1) If the City cancels an activity or program is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, instructor hardship, facility under repair or inclement weather, a full refund will be processed; or due to injury, family hardship, relocation or schedule change which would prohibit participation; or a participant presents a written recommendation from a doctor indicating that the individual should withdraw from an activity or program.

(2) If a participant requests to cancel a registration for a membership, activity or program due to injury, family hardship, relocation or schedule change which would prohibit participation, or if a participant presents a written recommendation from a doctor indicating that the individual should withdraw from an activity or program, a refund will be processed minus a \$25 cancellation fee. The City Manager has the discretion to approve a waiver of the cancellation fee.

Summer Camp Refund Policy:

Refunds for Summer Camp will be considered provided the request is received prior to June 1, minus a \$25 cancellation fee. Pro-rated refunds for medical reasons will be considered based on the date the request is received if accompanied by written documentation from a doctor indicating that the individual should withdraw from the program.

Installment Billing Termination:

Termination of a recurring payment authorization for an Achieve Anything Membership requires notification 15 days prior to the next billing date.
