(1) If an activity or program is cancelled by the City due to insufficient enrollment, instructor hardship, facility under repair or inclement weather, <del>a full refund will be processed, or due to injury, family hardship, relocation or schedule change which would prohibit participation; or a participant presents a written recommendation from a doctor indicating that the individual should withdraw from an activity or program.</del>			Clarification of process for City cancellation compared to participant cancellation
(2) If a participant requests to cancel a registration for a membership, activity or program due to injury, family hardship, relocation or schedule change which would prohibit participation; or if a participant presents a written recommendation from a doctor indicating that the individual should withdraw from an activity or program, a refund will be processed minus a \$25 cancellation fee.
