Whereas, it is fitting to set aside time to recognize the efforts of Habitat for Humanity in South Sarasota County and the labor of Habitat volunteers and the sweat equity contributed by families.

Now, Therefore, WE, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida, do hereby proclaim October 7, 2019 as

World Habitat Day

and call upon all citizens to join us in observing this day in the City of North Port.
