

Planning and Zoning Advisory Board 2019 Annual Report to City Commission

Pursuant to City Administrative Code Section 4-7 - Reports, all boards shall provide a verbal or written report to the City Commission including the previous year's activities and goals for the upcoming year. The following was approved by the Planning and Zoning Advisory Board to forward to Commission.

While 2018 was the most active for several years, with a resurgence of growth in the West Villages, 2019 was a busy year as well, with only 3 fewer items being heard by the board. The items that were brought to PZAB reflected an increase in large-scale development, indicating the beginning of a new development cycle. PZAB Agenda Items

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The number of petitions reviewed by the Planning and Zoning Advisory Board decreased by 7% compared to the prior year, however the complexity of the items heard increased. There were also trainings and a Joint Meeting with the Commission on the ULDC rewrite.
