







Sarasota County The Legacy Trail North Extension

Inter-Regional Trail


- Connects cities of North Port, Venice, Sarasota and on-road links to Long Boat Key
- March 29, 2017 County allocation: \$8.6 million
- Trust for Public Land (TPL) negotiating two (2) phase purchase of right-of-way.
- November 2018 Referendum

Project Highlights

- Project Limits: Pinebrook Road to Auburn Road
- Completes 1-Mile gap within City of Venice
- 10-ft. to 12-ft. Paved Multi-Use Path
- Projected Construction of July/August 2017

Myakkahatchee Creek Bridge

- Carlton Reserve to Myakkahatchee Trail Primitive/Multi-Use Trail
- Legal access to North Port via MECP Bridge in place
- Access to Half Mile Section (east of MECP) within Carlton Parcel East under negotiation.
- Ultimately can connect to Desoto County (River-to-River)
