Meeting Minutes - Final Planning & Zoning Advisory Board

CITY COMMISSION CHAMBERS

MINUTES APPROVED AT THE 04-04-2019 MEETING.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The Planning & Zoning Advisory Board Regular Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. in the City Chambers by Chair Nicholson.

2. ROLL CALL

Present: 4 - Thomas Nicholson Jr., John Metzger, James Sawyer and Nicholas Trolli

Absent: 2 - Kevin Rouse and Philip Lamade

Also Present:

Planning Division Manager Nicole Galehouse, Assistant City Attorney Michael Golen, and Recording Secretary Susan Hale.

3. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by the Board.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Approve Minutes for the February 7, 2019 Planning & Zoning Advisory Board Regular Meeting

A motion was made by Board Member Metzger, seconed by Board Member Trolli, to approve the February 7, 2019 Planning & Zoning Advisory Board Minutes as presented. The motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

6. PUBLIC HEARING

TXT-18-128

Ordinance No. 2019-10, Amending the Unified Land Development to Allow for Community Gardens in the Agricultural, Government Use, and Residential Zoning Districts, TXT-18-128

Ms. Galehouse provided an overview of the draft Ordinance and recommended approval in the specific districts as cited and with Staff conditions.

Discussion ensued: 1) individuals or groups may participate in a community garden; 2) ownership of the property or written permission from the owner is required; 3) the fee

charged is for the permit review to ensure conformance with all City requirements; 4) a variety of other community garden ordinances were used to craft this one; 5) Staff received Commission direction to draft legislation that regulated both community and commercial gardens which resulted in two separate Ordinances; 6) Chair Nicholson expressed that: [a] the gardens should only be permitted in the Agricultural Zoning District with 3.5 acres or more; [b] residential areas could be permitted to have farms; 7) Board Member Trolli voiced concern: [a] regarding the ability to enforce the criteria; and [b] neighbors cannot raise objections; 8) clarification was provided that clear-cutting a lot requires a Development Order (DO). There is no DO associated with this program and no ability to obtain a land-clearing permit. There was no public comment.

A motion was made by Board Member Metzger, seconded by Board Member Sawyer, that the Planning & Zoning Advisory Board recommends to the City Commission, to approve Ordinance No. 2019-10. The motion failed two-to-two (2-2) on a voice vote with Chair Nicholson and Board Member Trolli dissenting for reasons previously stated.

TXT-18-208

Ordinance No. 2019-11, Amending the Unified Land Development to Allow for Urban Market Gardens in the Commercial General, Commercial General – Special, Neighborhood Commercial, and Industrial Zoning Districts and in the Panacea, Midway, Shire and Gardens Activity Centers, TXT-18-208

Ms. Galehouse provided an overview of the draft Ordinance and recommended approval in the specific districts as cited and explained two separate actions: 1) to remove it as a permitted principal use, leaving the regulations in place and allow it to be considered as a special exception; or 2) allow urban market gardens as a permitted principal use or as a special exception through a pilot program.

Discussion ensued: 1) Staff's concern with diminishing the City's tax base and the safety of the building if erected without a permit because it is for a bona fide agricultural purpose; 2) a pilot program would give the City the ability to focus an area and oversee what develops prior to expanding to a City-wide program; 3) clarification was provided that the Board could recommend Option 1, Option 2, or a combination of both and thereafter, the options were clarified.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Hector Munoz: community gardens.

A motion was made by Board Member Sawyer, seconded by Board Member Metzger, that the Planning & Zoning Advisory Board recommends to the City Commission to approve Ordinance No. 2019-11 as it was written in its entirety and submitted as recommended by Staff, including Recommendations 1 and 2. The motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

7. PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

8. ADJOURNMENT

Chair Nicholson adjourned the Planning & Zoning Advisory Board Regular Meeting at 9:54 p.m.
