Background Information

Annually, the FDOT provides a lump sum payment to the City of North Port for the maintenance of streetlights on US 41.

For the period of July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020, the City will receive \$69,489.36 for maintenance of 265 streetlights. This is an increase from 124 streetlight in previous years. The following provides revenue and expenditure estimates:
