Background Information

On January 09, 2019 the North Port Police Department (NPPD) and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement entered into a Criminal Justice User Agreement granting the NPPD access to FDLE computer terminals for accessing the National Crime Information System (NCIC), and the Florida Crime Information Center (FCIC), through the Criminal Justice Network (CJNET).

NCIC can be described as an electronic clearinghouse of crime data that can be tapped into by virtually every criminal justice agency nationwide, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. It helps criminal justice professionals apprehend fugitives, locate missing persons, recover stolen property, and identify terrorists. It also assists law enforcement officers in performing their duties more safely and provides information necessary to protect the public.

The agreement permits the NPPD to provide criminal justice information through an interagency agreement to another

criminal justice agency, and the School Board Police Department is such an agency. This agreement will grant the School Board personnel member in our jurisdiction, within city limits, access to the NCIC, FCIC, and CJNET.

This agreement has been reviewed and approved for form and correctness by the City Attorney.
