The City of North Port will provide this information to citizens through the Sarasota County TRIM (Truth in Millage) Notice and Notice of Proposed Taxes.

The Fiscal year 2022-2023 Solid Waste District Non-Ad Valorem Assessment rate is hereby requested to be established and confirmed to be \$250.00 for each residential unit for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.
