Description: Commission directed city attorney at November 4 meeting to bring back an ordinance amending commissioner salary calculation starting compensation baseline at its current amount, increasing annually based on that same cost of living increase approved for city employees. Essentially, whatever cost of living increase city employees get commission also gets, if there is no increase across the board then commission gets no increase. A motion was made by Vice Mayor Emrich, seconded by Commissioner Langdon, to direct the City Attorney to draft an ordinance for Commission compensation starting the new compensation at the baseline of what it is at right now adding what is comparable for the City employee cost of living increases annually.
