



## Six Month Impact Statement

### Define your non-profits missions/goals?

Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Sun Coast's mission is to create and support one-to-one mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth. Its vision is for all youth to achieve their full potential.

Our goal is that our clients have the tools and support needed to achieve academically, gain the capacity to achieve their potential, and live a life of resilience, financial self-sufficiency, and good citizenship.

### Indicators or methods used to measure impact?

We utilized NP2's \$1,690 grant award to purchase 5 Lenovo IdeaPads for our North Port High School students that do not have access to technology at home, such that they may use these IdeaPads when they are receiving site-based one-to-one mentoring services.

The demographics of the at-risk North Port students served are as follows:

- 62% Male, 38% Female
- 78% subsidized school lunches
- 50% live below the federal poverty level
- 35% have an incarcerated parent
- 77% live with a single parent
- 16% live in a two-parent household
- 7% live with a guardian, non-parent relative, or in foster care
- 23% are Black or African-American; 13% are Hispanic or Latino; 47% are White; 17% are multi-racial or of another race/ethnicity

Rates of timely grade level promotion and high school graduation will be reported in the 12-month impact statement (after the end of this 2025-26 academic year). This is measured utilizing report cards that the Sarasota County School District provides to us pursuant to our interagency agreement.
