



# City of North Port

## ORDINANCE NO. 2024-47

1           **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE**  
 2           **CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 46, ARTICLE II, SECTION 46-45 REGARDING**  
 3           **EXCEPTIONS TO NOISE VIOLATIONS; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR**  
 4           **CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND**  
 5           **PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

 8           **WHEREAS**, the City Commission recognizes that excessive noises can degrade the quality of life, disturb  
 9           the public peace, and jeopardize the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port,  
 10          Florida (the “City”); and  
 11

12          **WHEREAS**, the City Commission recognizes that large construction and repair projects of public  
 13          infrastructure can impact the roadway system resulting in increased travel times and the potential for  
 14          additional conflicts between vehicular and pedestrian traffic during peak travel times; and  
 15

16          **WHEREAS**, the City Commission recognizes the opportunity to reduce the impact on traffic if roadwork is  
 17          completed during off peak travel times, including overnight and early mornings; and  
 18

19          **WHEREAS**, the City's existing noise control language was developed over thirty-years ago and the purpose  
 20          of this Ordinance is to amend the current regulations to outline the ability to address public infrastructure  
 21          construction, repair, and maintenance outside of peak travel times; and  
 22

23          **WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that these amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare  
 24          of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.  
 25

26          **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:**

28          **SECTION 1 – FINDINGS**  
 29

- 30          1.01     The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this ordinance by reference.

- 32          1.02     In accordance with Florida Statutes Section 166.041(4)(a), the City timely posted a business  
 33          impact estimate on the City’s website on or before the date the newspaper published notice of  
 34          this ordinance’s final reading.

36 **SECTION 2 – ADOPTION**

38 2.01 Chapter 46 of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida is hereby amended as follows:

40 **“Chapter 46 – OFFENSES**

41 . . .

42 **ARTICLE II. – OFFENSES INVOLVING PUBLIC PEACE AND ORDER**

43 . . .

44 **DIVISION 2. – NOISE**

45 . . .

46 **Sec. 46-45. - Exceptions ~~by special permit.~~**

47

48 (a) Special permit exception. Any person desiring to seek relief from any provision of this  
49 division shall apply to the city commission for a special permit to cause or create noise at  
50 levels which would otherwise be in violation of this division. Such permits shall be granted  
51 only upon the showing of good cause therefor and shall specify the duration for which  
52 such noncompliance shall be permitted and shall prescribe the conditions or  
53 requirements necessary to minimize adverse effects upon the community or surrounding  
54 neighborhood.

56 (b) Emergency work exception. Noise created exclusively in the performance of emergency  
57 work completed by the city or a city contractor in response to any infrastructure  
58 emergency that if left unaddressed would impact the life, safety, or health of the  
59 community including, but not limited to, disruption of water or sewer service, emergency  
60 repairs to bridges and arterial and collector roadways are automatically exempt from the  
61 provisions of this section. All exempt activity shall be confirmed via written approval from  
62 the city manager.

63

64 (c) Capital improvement plan exception. The following are automatically exempt from the  
65 provisions of this section. All exempt activity shall be confirmed via written approval from  
66 the city manager.

67

68 (1) Planned construction work - Work completed as part of any project approved within  
69 the city’s approved capital improvement plan including, but not limited to, the  
70 construction, maintenance, or repair of any public utility, right-of-way, property, or  
71 structure.

72

73 (2) Solid waste collection - During City of North Port road construction, utility projects,  
74 or capital repair projects which have anticipated impacts on travel times and roadway  
75 conditions expected to last more than four (4) continuous days in duration, solid  
76 waste collection vehicles are permitted to begin service collection to the residents  
77 and business within the construction zone at 6:00 a.m. weekdays, weekends, and  
78 holidays to help alleviate additional congestion within the construction zone area.”

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, in whole or in part, the provisions of this ordinance will prevail to the extent of the conflict.

**SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY**

4.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

**SECTION 5 – CODIFICATION**

5.01 In this ordinance, additions are shown as underlined and deletions as ~~striketrough~~. Any additional codification information and notations appear in *italics*. These editorial notations are not intended to appear in the codified text.

**SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE**

6.01 This ordinance takes effect immediately upon adoption.
