WHEREAS, the U.S. House of Representatives has designated July as Parks and Recreation Month.

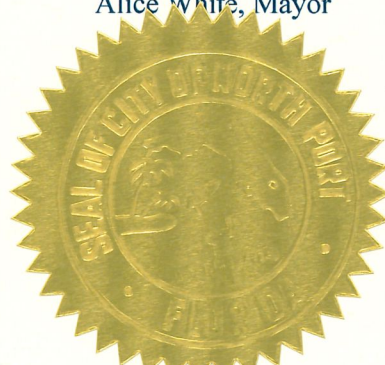
