## 4. GENERAL BUSINESS:

<u>20-2164</u> Discussion and Possible Action for Long Range Plan for Solid Waste Organics, Garbage and Recycling Transfer Stations

City Manager introduced the item.

Mr. Lama provided a presentation regarding the Public Works Solid Waste District long rang plan for Solid Waste organics, garbage and recycling transfer stations, December 6, 2019 meeting discussion, history of North Port landfill sites, recycling and organics disposal sites, current collection processing of organic waste, estimated disposal transfer and cost options, staff recommendation of option 2 and proposed North Yorkshire Street Yard Waste transfer station site.

Discussion ensued regarding the June 25, 2020 motion to direct staff to bring back a variety of properties private and publicly owned, clarification that the direction was for a garbage transfer station and not a yard waste transfer station, clarification that the proposed site for the transfer station is not the property for a planned park, the proposed property being under Road and Drainage ownership and would be transferred to Solid Waste.

Mr. Lama continued his presentation including the design of the transfer station and onsite staff requirements.

Discussion ensued regarding review of the shared cost for recycle center and organics transfer station, difference between in-house and contracted costs, timeline for recovering the cost of the proposed equipment, routing plan for trucks and scheduling of hauling from both stations, concern with employee safety, method of loading organics for transport, land clearing and site preparation cost included in the start up cost, and cost for transfer of property.

A motion was made by Vice Mayor Luke, seconded by Commissioner Emrich, to approve option 2, Solid Waste Semi Truck In House Transfer Organics Syunagro - Start Up Cost (1- Chassis, 3- Walking Floor Trailers, 1- Property 10 acres) as presented.

Ms. Taylor read the following public comment into the record: Greg Smith: Biomass Management LLC solutions for biomass issues.

The motion carried on the following voice vote:
