RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING CITY COMMISSION POLICY NO. 2021-05 RELATED TO COMMISSION MEETING SCHEDULES, NOTICES, AND AGENDAS; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2025, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2025-R-10, amending City Commission Policy No. 2021-05, entitled "Commission Meeting Schedules, Notices, and Agendas;" and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to revise the policy to include non-substantive formatting and editorial revisions and to update the Consent Agenda provision to include authorizations adopted in Resolution No. 2025-R-64, that establish the Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) as the administrative authority for plat approval; and

WHEREAS, this amended Policy No. 2021-05 supersedes and takes the place of all previous versions of the policy; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that this policy serves the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – INCORPORATION OF RECITALS

1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this resolution by reference.

SECTION 2 – ADOPTION

2.01 The City Commission hereby adopts Policy No. 2021-05, "Commission Meeting Schedules, Notices, and Agendas," attached and incorporated as if set forth in this resolution, as an administrative policy of the City Commission of the City of North Port.

2.02 All previous versions of Policy No. 2021-05, including but not limited to the version adopted by Resolution No. 2025-R-10, are superseded and replaced by the policy adopted herein.

SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution, in whole or in part, the provisions of this resolution will prevail to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY

4.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the resolution.

SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE

5.01 This resolution takes effect immediately.
