During the Art Advisory Board Meeting on April 09, 2024, the following actions were taken by the Board:

- > Discussion took place regarding a potential Garden of Five Senses Sculpture.
 - Discussion took place regarding timeline, review process, and permitting requirements
 - Motion was made by Board Member, Loos, seconded by Board Member Gozion, to request the Parks and Recreation Department review the sculpture proposal. Motion carried by unanimous by voice vote.
- There was discussion regarding a 65th Anniversary Project.
 - Board member Gozion provided the board with cost and logistic information for purchasing 65 peace poles to celebrate the City's 65th Anniversary.
 - Discussion took place regarding costs, project planning, timeline, volunteers, taxes, and legal review of contract.
 - A motion was made by Board Member Gozion, seconded by Vice Chair Kang, to request Commission approval to proceed with the Peace Pole Project. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.
- Updates regarding the First Floor Canvas Mural and Community Education Center Mural were provided.
 - The First Floor Canvas Mural, has been completed.
 - The Community Education Center Mural, being completed by artist Laura Pucci, is expected to be finalized in May.
