



February Accomplishments

Aquatics:

- Learn to Yak had 5 participants who developed kayaking skills and tested their abilities in open water, building confidence and techniques.
- CPR & First Aid saw 4 participants gaining essential life-saving skills.
- Learn to Swim had a strong turnout with 32 participants building water confidence and safety.
- Staff are actively engaged in full facility training to ensure readiness for a busy spring break.

Recreation:

- We loved seeing 437 community members come together to celebrate our four-legged friends with activities, vendors, and lots of happy barks.
- Community Yard Sale & Newcomers Day saw nearly 500 attendees who found great deals, met new neighbors, and strengthened our sense of community through networking with local businesses and non-profits.
- Go Green with Parks had sustainability in action and took steps toward a greener future with an educational session on home landscape and native plantings followed by an activity on plants absorbing nutrients finishing the afternoon with two garden bed plantings of over 100 donated plants.

Maintenance:

- In preparation for Little League opening day, the maintenance team installed 4 new batting cage nets at Atwater Park along with repairing the scoreboard on field 3.
- Park Maintenance groundskeeping team installed posts at Warm Mineral Springs to eliminate parking up on the grass areas.
- The Park Maintenance team refreshed the entrance of the Morgan Family Center with new plants and repaired the scoreboards on fields 2 and 4 at Butler Park.
