RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE NON-DISTRICT BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 RELATING TO HURRICANE IAN UTILITIES PURCHASES, INCREASE TO UTILITIES BUILDING PROJECT U18UAB, UTILITIES LIFT STATION PROJECT, AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY, A MOBILE LIFT SYSTEM AND MAINTENANCE COSTS FOR FLEET, SIX (6) JOHN DEERE MOWERS FOR ROAD AND DRAINAGE, CRANBERRY AND TOLEDO BLADE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT R23CTI, 175 INTERCHANGE AT TOLEDO BLADE PROJECT R22I75, 175 INTERCHANGE AT SUMTER PROJECT R2275S, PRICE WIDENING PHASE II PROJECT R25PW2 AND YORKSHIRE RAINTREE INTERCHANGE PROEJCT R23YRI IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,210,747; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR POSTING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2022-R-53 approved the Non-District Budget and Capital Improvement Budget for fiscal year 2022-2023; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 166.241(7)(c) requires that a budget amendment be adopted in the same manner as the original budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to amend the Non-District Budget and Capital Improvement Budget for supplemental appropriations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – FINDINGS

SECTION 5 – SEVERABILITY

5.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the resolution.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE

6.01 This resolution takes effect immediately.
