### **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-05**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, CALLING FOR A REFERENDUM QUESTION TO BE PLACED BEFORE THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA AT A SPECIAL ELECTION; PROVIDING A REFERENDUM QUESTION DETERMINING WHETHER TO FINANCE CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO A WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY THROUGH THE ISSUANCE BY THE CITY OF BONDS PAYABLE FROM THE REVENUES OF THE CITY'S WATER AND SEWER UTILITY SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF THE ORDINANCE WITH THE SARASOTA COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable and in the best interests of the City to construct improvements to an existing effluent pumping station at the wastewater treatment facility located on Pan American Boulevard and a new 30" effluent force main between the pumping station and the existing deep injection well, as more particularly described in the plans and specifications on file with the City (the "Effluent Pumping Station Project"), in order to promote, improve, maintain, and protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the most efficient and fair method of financing costs of the Effluent Pumping Station Project is through the issuance of bonds (the "Bonds") secured by and payable from the revenues, charges, fees, and assessments derived from the City's water and sewer utility system (the "Water and Sewer Utility Revenues"); and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the North Port City Charter, the question as to whether or not such Bonds should be issued to finance costs of the Effluent Pumping Station Project must be submitted to the qualified electors of the City at a primary, general, or special election; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission authorizes that a referendum question concerning the issuance of the Bonds for the purpose of financing costs of the Effluent Pumping Station Project be submitted to the qualified electors of the City at a special election to be held on May 13, 2025, for consideration by the City's voters; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sarasota County Supervisor of Elections (the "Supervisor of Elections") advises that in order to obtain placement on the ballot for a May 13, 2025, special election, the Supervisor of Elections has established a deadline of February 17, 2025 for the submission of referendum questions.

52	SECTION 3 – CONDUCT OF REFERENDUM ELECTION			
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54	3.01	The Referendum Election called by this ordinance will be conducted in the manner prescribed in		
55		Florida Statutes Chapters 100, 101, and 102.

57	3.02	The polling places, election officials, and hours of election for the Referendum Election will be as		
58		determined by the Supervisor of Elections in accordance with applicable Florida law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

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#### **SECTION 4 – FORM OF BALLOT**

The question pertaining to whether to finance a portion of the Effluent Pumping Station Project through the issuance of bonds in one or more series, payable from the Water and Sewer Utility Revenues will be submitted to the qualified electors of the City in substantially the following form and will be printed on the ballot:

To finance capital improvements to the City's wastewater treatment facility located on Pan American Boulevard, shall the City of North Port be authorized to issue bonds in one or more series in a total aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$17,000,000, maturing no later than 30 years from issuance, bearing interest at no more than the maximum lawful rate and payable from the revenues of the City's water and sewer utility system?

YES – For Bonds

NO – Against Bonds

### **SECTION 5 – NOTICE OF ELECTION**

5.01 The City Clerk is directed to make this ordinance available for inspection at the office of the City Clerk and available on the City's website at www.northportfl.gov.

5.02 The City Clerk is directed to publish a notice of the referendum election in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of North Port at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the election. The notice must be published at least twice, once in the fifth week and once in the third week prior to the week in which the referendum election is to be held. The notice must be in substantially the following form:

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155	8.02	If a majority of the votes cast for the referendum question is "YES – For Bonds," then the	
156		referendum question will be approved and become effective as of 12:01 a.m. on the day following	
157		the certification of the referendum results.

159	8.03	If less than a majority of the votes cast for the referendum question is "YES – For Bonds," then	
160		the referendum question will be defeated and will not be effective or operative, and the same	
161		shall be void and have no effect.
