ORDINANCE NO. 2025-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, SECTION 2-510 REGARDING SUBPOENA PROCEDURES RELATED TO CODE ENFORCEMENT HEARINGS; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 162.08 authorizes a municipal code enforcement board to issue subpoenas for testimony and production of documents to alleged violators and witnesses to its hearings; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Chapter 162 provides for the use of a Special Magistrate in addition to or in lieu of a code enforcement board; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Florida Statutes Chapter 162, Section 2-505 of the Code of the City of North Port ("City Code") establishes the City's hearing officer, who acts as a Special Magistrate in lieu of a code enforcement board; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-510 of the City Code provides the City's subpoena procedures and requires the City Clerk to issue subpoenas for witness testimony and the production of documents upon request for the same to be presented before the City's hearing officer; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the City Code's requirement that the City Clerk issue subpoenas for witness testimony and the production of documents should be amended to comply with the requirements of Florida Statutes Section 162.08, authorizing the City's hearing officer to perform those duties; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that these amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – FINDINGS

1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this ordinance by reference.

1.02 In accordance with Florida Statutes Section 166.041(4)(a), the City timely posted a business impact estimate on the City's website on or before the date the newspaper published notice of this ordinance's final reading.

SECTION 2 – ADOPTION

2.01 Chapter 2 of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida is hereby amended as follows:

"Chapter 2 – ADMINISTRATION

.

ARTICLE IX. - CODE ENFORCEMENT

. .

Sec. 2-510. – Subpoena Procedures.

(a) Subpoena for testimony before the hearing officer. Every subpoena for testimony before the hearing officer shall be issued by the clerk to the city commission hearing officer under the seal of the city. Each subpoena shall be prepared by the party requesting its issuance and shall state the name of the hearing officer, the title of the action, the case number of the action, the name and address of the person to whom the subpoena is issued and the time, place, and location of the hearing at which the person is directed to appear and shall be prepared by the party requesting issuance.

(b) Subpoena for production of documentary evidence. A subpoena may also command the person to whom it is directed to produce the books, papers, documents, or tangible items designated therein. The hearing officer upon motion by a party and promptly and in any event at or before the time specified in the subpoena for compliance therewith, may quash or modify the subpoena if it is unreasonable and oppressive or condition denial of the motion upon the advancement by the person in whose behalf the subpoena is issued of the reasonable cost of producing the books, papers, documents, or tangible items.

(c) Service of subpoenas. A subpoena may be served by the sheriff of the county where the person to be served is found or by the city police department. Service is made by delivering a copy of the subpoena to the person to be served or by leaving the copies at his their usual place of abode with any person residing therein who is 15 years of age or older and informing the person of their contents. All officers to whom subpoenas have been directed for service shall note on the original subpoena the time it comes into his the officer's possession, the time when it is executed, the manner of execution and the name of the person on whom it was executed. The original subpoena shall be filed with the clerk of the city commission to the hearing officer. Payment of any service fee shall be made by the party at whose request the service is made.

(d) Witness fee and payment. Persons subpoenaed shall be entitled to a witness fee and mileage compensation as provided for in F.S. § 92.142. The cost of the witness fee and mileage compensation shall be borne by the party at whose request the subpoena is issued and shall be paid to the witness at or before the time of service. Failure to timely pay the witness fee and mileage compensation shall render the subpoena void.
