#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-14**

 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, APPENDIX A – CITY FEE SCHEDULE; AMENDING CITY-WIDE FEES; DEVELOPMENT SERVICES – DEVELOPMENT REVIEW, PLANNING AND ZONING, AND NATURAL RESOURCES FEES; DEVELOPMENT SERVICES – CODE ENFORCEMENT FEES; FIRE RESCUE DISTRICT FEES; POLICE FEES; PARKS AND RECREATION – GENERAL FEES, PARKS AND RECREATION – FACILITY RENTAL FEES; SOLID WASTE DISTRICT FEES; UTILITIES FEES; ROAD AND DRAINAGE DISTRICT FEES; SOCIAL SERVICES FEES; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida has the duty, right, power, and authority to levy and collect fees for municipal purposes, including user fees as set forth in Florida Statutes Section 166.201; and

WHEREAS, the City's fees provide funding for municipal purposes, including but not limited to, conducting municipal government, performing municipal functions, and rendering municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the City Fee Schedule is codified as Appendix A to the Code of the City of North Port, Florida;

**WHEREAS**, on March 3, 2025, Willdan Financial Services, prepared the *North Port Florida 2025 Comprehensive User Fee Study*; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to update the City Fee Schedule; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Commission finds that these amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1 – FINDINGS** 

41 1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this ordinance by reference. 42 43 1.02 In accordance with Florida Statutes Section 166.041(4)(a), the City timely posted a business 44 impact estimate on the City's website on or before the date the newspaper published notice of 45 this ordinance's final reading. 46 47 1.03 The City Commission finds that the fees established in this ordinance are fair, reasonable, just, 48 and equitable. 49 50 1.04 The City Commission further finds that the building fees established in this ordinance: 51 52 a. Are reasonable; 53 b. Relate to the level of service provided by the City; 54 c. Shall be used solely for carrying out the City's responsibilities in enforcing the Florida 55 Building Code and any other allowable activities per Florida Statutes Section 553.80; and 56 d. Do not exceed the total estimated annual costs of allowable activities per Florida Statutes 57 Section 553.80. 58 59 1.05 The City Commission finds that the regulatory fees established in this ordinance do not exceed 60 the cost of the regulatory activity and are calculated to pay the cost of the regulatory activity for 61 which they are imposed. 62 63 1.06 The City Commission finds that the user fees established in this ordinance are imposed in the 64 exercise of a proprietary activity and benefit the party paying the fee in a manner not shared by 65 the general public. 66 67 1.07 The City Commission finds that, pursuant to Section 14 of Chapter 2023-304, Laws of Florida, the 68 changes to the land development-related fees are not more restrictive or burdensome than 69 current fees. **SECTION 2 – COMPREHENSIVE USER FEE ANALYSIS** 70 71 72 2.01 On March 3, 2025, Willdan Financial Services prepared the North Port Florida 2025 73 Comprehensive User Fee Study. 74 75 2.02 The City Commission approves, adopts, and incorporates herein by reference, the North Port 76 Florida 2025 Comprehensive User Fee Study, attached hereto as "Exhibit A." 77 78 **SECTION 3 – ADOPTION** 79 80 Appendix A of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida is hereby amended as follows: 3.01
