



## Six Month Impact Statement

Define your non-profits missions/goals?

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul, San Pedro Conference, leads men and women to join together to grow spiritually by offering person to person service to the needy and suffering in the North Port area. SVdP collaborates with other service agencies in relieving need and addressing its causes. The members grow together in holiness and friendship by providing spiritual and material assistance to people in need.

Indicators or methods used to measure impact?

Neighbors in need in North Port contact SVdP in two ways. Phone calls come in to a call line where voice messages are transcribed into an email that is sent to our email account. These calls are then returned via our cell phone. Additionally, some requests for assistance come in directly to the cell phone. In both instances, further contact with the requestor is via the cell phone. The number of calls and requests that are received is one of the indicators of our impact in the community, and is the one that is directly related to the NP2 grant we received for a refurbished cell phone.

The attached spreadsheet details financial assistance disbursed during the 4 months the new phone has been in use. Other calls that have not resulted in financial assistance during the time period is 150+.
