RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE 2023 COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN AS THE FORMAL GUIDE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT'S EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES; INCORPORATING RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, because the City of North Port has implemented an emergency management program, Florida Administrative Code Rule 27P-6.010 requires that the City Commission must adopt an approved plan by resolution before it becomes the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan for the City; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (the "Plan") provides a detailed description of the hazards, consequences, emergencies, or disasters that may be generated by natural, technological, or manmade causes within the City, as well as the processes to follow in the event of such hazards, consequences, emergencies, or disasters occurring within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Sarasota County Department of Emergency Management has reviewed and determined that the Plan complies with the established criteria as required by Florida Administrative Code Rule 27P-6.010; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida, finds that the Plan serves the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – INCORPORATION OF RECITALS

1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this resolution by reference.

SECTION 2 – ADOPTING COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN

2.01 The City Commission hereby adopts the 2023 Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, attached as Exhibit A, as the formal guide for the City of North Port's emergency management activities.

2.02 All identified exhibits are incorporated in this resolution by reference.

SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution, in whole or in part, the provisions of this resolution will prevail to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY

4.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the resolution.

SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE

5.01 This resolution takes effect immediately.
