ORDINANCE NO. 2024-20

1 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, REPEALING SECTION 34-1 OF**
2 **THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, RELATING TO MOBILE FOOD**
3 **VENDORS; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR**
4 **SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

5
6 **WHEREAS**, on August 6, 2024, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2024-13, providing for the
7 repeal of Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), Chapters 1, 5, 9, 13, 14, 17, 18, 21, 25, 28, 33, 37, 41,
8 45, 49, 53, 55, 57, 58, 59, 60, and 61, and replacement of those chapters with Chapters 1 through 4 and
9 6, and Appendices; and

11 **WHEREAS**, processes and regulations related to mobile food vendors, currently located in Section 34-1 of
12 the Code of the City of North Port, Florida, appear in the newly adopted Unified Land Development Code;
13 and

15 **WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that these amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare
16 of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:**

20 **SECTION 1 – FINDINGS**

21
22 1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this ordinance by reference.

23
24 1.02 In accordance with Florida Statutes Section 166.041(4)(a), the City timely posted a business
25 impact estimate on the City’s website on or before the date the newspaper published notice of
26 this ordinance’s final reading.

28 **SECTION 2 – REPEAL**

29
30 2.01 Section 34-1, entitled “Mobile food vendor,” of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida is
31 hereby repealed in its entirety.

33 **SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS**

34
35 3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, in
36 whole or in part, the provisions of this ordinance will prevail to the extent of the conflict.

38 **SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY**

40 4.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase,
41 or provision of this ordinance is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be
42 deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the
43 remaining portions of the ordinance.

45 **SECTION 5 – CODIFICATION**

47 5.01 In this ordinance, additions are shown as underlined and deletions as ~~striketrough~~. Any
48 additional codification information and notations appear in *italics*. These editorial notations are
49 not intended to appear in the codified text.

51 **SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE**

53 6.01 This ordinance takes effect on October 28, 2024.
