**NARRATIVE**

On Wednesday 2/8/23 at 1911hrs. I arrived at 2758 Morrietta Ln. for the purpose of issuing a trespass warning to Mark Alan Stern (12/22/58).

I was advised by Sgt. Guzman that the North Port City Manager was requesting Mr. Stern be trespass warned from City Hall. I completed the trespass form and signed it. Sgt. Guzman, acting as the on-duty Watch Commander, signed the warning as an agent of the city requesting the warning.

Upon my arrival I found the property to include the driveway fenced and closed. I contacted Mr. Stern via telephone, and he agreed to step outside and speak with me. Upon making face to face contact I explained that he was being trespass warned from City Hall in its entirety and that there is a process

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whereby he can request a hearing to appeal this decision. I asked him to sign the form and he refused. At that point, I verbally explained that his refusal to sign did not change anything and that the trespass warning is valid and in effect. I also explained violation of the warning is an arrestable offense. I provided him with his copy of NPPD form 126, Written Notice of Public Property Trespass Warning. Mr. Stern had several questions regarding the legality of the warning and challenging who from the city was responsible. The process to appeal was again explained to him and he stated he will be following up on 2/9/23.

A flag showing the warning was placed in RMS and the original paperwork was submitted to Records at NPPD.

This occurred in the City of North Port, Sarasota County, Florida.

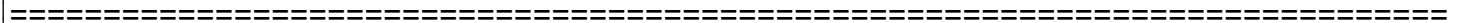
