



January - February Accomplishments

Aquatics:

- 28 patrons participated in the Eco Adventures tour at Senator Bob Johnson Landing.
- With 2026 seasonal recruiting underway and attracting over 40 interested applicants, the onboarding process for seasonal lifeguards has begun in preparation for full facility operations.
- NPAC enrolled 14 participants in Learn to Swim sessions, 17 in private sessions, and conducted kayaking courses.
- Community outreach and recruitment was completed at North Port High School and Imagine School of North Port.
- Over 10,100 patrons visited WMSP during the month of February.
- Fence maintenance to reinforce the perimeter was completed at WMSP.

Recreation:

- Hosted the annual Rockin' Run & Roll 5K, promoting health and wellness for 216 participants.
- Launched the E-Sports Lounge at the Morgan Family Community Center.
- Hosted a Nature Walk at the Myakkahatchee Greenway Trail with local Scout Troops to support invasive species removal.
- Go Green with Parks welcomed over 45 individuals to Marina Park to partake in (4) interactive stations focused on saltwater and brackish water ecosystems.
- Community Yard Sale and Newcomers Day saw over 1,000 attendees.
- Woofstock drew in over 280 attendees and 19 merchandise vendors.

Maintenance:

- Installed new signs for the Little League fields at Atwater Park and laser graded fields 1 & 2.
- Installed new scorer's tables at the Narramore Softball fields.
- Painted over graffiti on the concrete at the Skate Park.
- Installed wooden fencing and prepped for Grand Opening at Boca Chica Park.
- Repaired broken waterline at the Canine Club.
