



March Accomplishments

Aquatics:

- Thirteen new lifeguards were certified, 19 Lifeguards returned from last season.
- Junior Lifeguard program had five participants attend! Several students will return this summer to shadow.
- NPAC had its first audit, meeting 100% of the standards set by the American Red Cross *Recreation:*
 - The annual Book Swap hosted 92 attendees giving them over 1,700 books, games, puzzles, and movies to choose from.
 - Community Yard Sale had 50 registered vendors with an array of items and over 700 attendees.
 - Our annual Egg Hunt events saw a combined attendance of over 1,500 children between the ages of 3 and 12, eager to hunt over 40,000 eggs.
