

March Accomplishments

Aquatics:

- Thirteen new lifeguards were certified, 19 Lifeguards returned from last season.
- Junior Lifeguard program had five participants attend! Several students will return this summer to shadow.
- NPAC had its first audit, meeting 100% of the standards set by the American Red Cross

Recreation:
