Capital Improvement Project P22PAS, Boca Chica Neighborhood Park, is slated for consideration during the Fiscal Year 21/22 budget process with \$300,000 in funding anticipated via a Park Impact fee allocation. The proposed park location is a 4.2-acre site located on Boca Chica Avenue between Ponds Street and Oceanside Street. Development of this site aligns with the City of North Port's Strategic Priority to "Expand access to community recreation, green space and Blueways for public enjoyment."

During a Commission Workshop on June 18, 2020 there was Commission consensus to re-evaluate Boca Chica neighborhood public input. Parks & Recreation developed an eight-question survey, and copies of the survey were mailed to 140 houses neighboring the potential park location. Additionally, advertisement was done via a press release, email notifications, and social media posts (via the Parks & Recreation and the City's Facebook pages, Nextdoor and Twitter) which guided readers to a website landing page that was developed for this project. The survey was available for four-weeks between November 11 and December 8, 2020 and garnered 162 responses.

The survey provided residents the opportunity to give input on what type of park, if any, they would like to see developed in their neighborhood and what features and amenities are most desired. Additionally, questions were structured to obtain information such as expected frequency of use, and household information including age of family members and distance from their household to the proposed park location.

Key survey results, and the most popular responses are highlighted below; all results are provided in the attachment.

Development of a park in this area is supported by 96% of those that responded. A total of seven responses, approximately 4%, indicated that they do not support this park. The majority of respondents prioritized an active neighborhood park that features trees, natural shade and a walking path. Desired amenities included picnic tables, a restroom and playground equipment. Survey results did not support a design that included public art or a decorative fountain, also low interest was received for athletic fields/sports courts, an off leash dog park or a community garden.

Following the completion of the survey, Parks & Recreation has received two emails from neighbors of the property stating that they did not complete the survey but are not in favor of a park in this area. Additionally one neighbor of the property called Parks & Recreation to state their support for the park. Since this input was not received through the survey, it is not included in the survey analysis below.

Survey Question Response Analysis

Question One asked respondents to provide direction on what type of park they would like to see at this site and offered three response options: Active Neighborhood Park, Passive Neighborhood Park, or Other. A majority of respondents (62%) selected an "Active Neighborhood Park" designed to promote physical activity, fitness and sports. The second most popular choice, at 37% was a "Passive Neighborhood Park" designed to promote nature observation, walking and enjoyment of open space. The "Other" option saw a 27% response rate with a majority stating the desire for a playground or a combination of the options. Comments received support inclusion of trails, a pet friendly park, and child/family-oriented offerings.

Question Two asked respondents to provide direction on what type of general features they would like to see at the park, listing ten answer choices including an "Other" option to write in a response. Respondents were able to select multiple features. The top two answers were trees/shade (88%) and a walking path (75%). Natural areas (flower beds, landscaping), parking, and security lighting were also strong performers with each seeing at least a 51% selection rate. The "Other" option saw a 29% response rate with 46 total comments with 25 responses noting a desire for a playground. A decorative fountain and public art/sculptures received less than 25% of selections.

Question Three asked respondents to provide direction on what type of amenities they would like to see at this park listing twenty potential responses including an "Other" option to write in a unique response. The top three answers were picnic tables (78%), a restroom (74%), and playground equipment (70%). Two additional strong performing answers were benches and small shelters/pavilions, which received above a 64% selection rate. All other options were below a 50% selection rate with football/soccer field, baseball/softball field, and shuffleboard courts each receiving less than 13% selection rate. Evaluation of the comments did not reveal an overarching theme, however, did highlight many unique responses based on individual preferences with references to cell phone charging stations, corn hole, frisbee golf, skatepark, and pickleball.

Question Four asked respondents to indicate how often they would visit the park if it was developed and listed six answer choices ranging from every day to less than once a month. The top response was "a few times a week" with almost 50% of respondents selecting this option. All other answer choices received less than a 20% selection rate with the bottom two answer choices being "less than once a month" and "once a month". In total, 82% of respondents indicated they would visit the park at least once per week.

Question Five was an open-ended question that asked for the respondent's street address. Almost all respondents listed a street address or street name, with only five responses refraining from providing a relevant answer. Of these responses received, over half (56%) indicated that they live less than 2 miles from the proposed park location. The chart below and the attached map outline the response distribution.

Question Six asked participants to indicate the age range of each adult in the household, listing six age ranges between 18 and 70+. Respondents indicated that they have an adult age 30-39 (51%) in their household, followed by 30% indicating they have an adult aged 40-49 in the household. The age ranges with the least household representation were age 50-59 and 60-69, both received less than a 10% response rate each.

Questions Seven asked participants to indicate age ranges of children in the household listing four age range options between 0-17 and a "N/A" option. Respondents could select all applicable age ranges. The standout response for this survey question is the age range of 5-12, with 75 residents noted in that group.

Question Eight was an open-ended question that invited participants to provide any additional feedback about the proposed park site. Over 60 participants provided relevant feedback comments, with many reiterating responses from earlier questions. The most common theme expressed was accessibility to or walkability of the park, 18 comments expressed a "close to my home" accessible theme and an additional six comments referenced walkability in the park. Fifteen comments referenced family and community gathering as a favorable value.

Comment quips

- "...I live right by there and there are a lot of children in the neighborhood that would enjoy a park within walking/biking distance."
- "Would love to see a playground with plenty of shade for kids and maybe a garden they can

learn and explore."


- * "Would love another splash pad type park that has a playground. Atwater's playground isn't really great for young kids and the splash pad is always so crowded!"
- ...Love the wild life and would love to have walking paths through the area. Dirt or even synthetic surfaces used in other parks to walk on."
- "There are many teens and kids in the area I see using skateboards and bikes. It would be nice to have a safe place for these kids to be at to do what they like and possibly make friends there! I see this as a win win for the kids and for any of their parent's safety worries."
- * "Would LOVE to see a nature trail or small playground within walking distance of our house."
- "I love being a resident of North Port due to the amount of parks and fun places for our family. Having active areas for children with their parents helps build strong families!"

Based on the responses from this survey, Parks & Recreation will recommend funding of Capital Improvement Project P22PAS within the FY21-22 budget process to develop the park to include a playground, walking paths, benches, and similar amenities.



Q2 What type of features would you like to see at this park? (check all that apply)









Q3 What type of amenities would you like to see at this park? (check all that apply)










