RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE NON-DISTRICT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 FOR TEN ADDITIONAL POLICE OFFICERS TO INCLUDE SALARY, BENEFITS, OPERATING COSTS AND VEHICLES AND INCREASE TO THE FIRE IMPACT FEE CAPITAL CONTRIBUTION TO WELLEN PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,309,180; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR POSTING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2023-R-59 approved the Non-District Budget and Capital Improvement Budget for fiscal year 2023-2024; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 166.241(7)(c) requires that a budget amendment be adopted in the same manner as the original budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to amend the Non-District Budget for supplemental appropriations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – FINDINGS

1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this resolution by reference.

SECTION 2 – ADOPTION

2.01 The **Non-District Budget** for fiscal year 2023-2024 is amended and appropriated as follows:

4.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution, in whole or in part, the provisions of this resolution will prevail to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5 – SEVERABILITY

5.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the resolution.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE

6.01 This resolution takes effect immediately.
